Camp Theme 2018: **Peculiar**

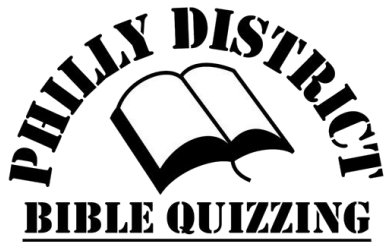

Our last report shared details about our kick-off quiz and the beginning of the quiz year. The first half of the year has been quite a challenge for various reasons.

As we shared previously, this year we only had one Varsity quizzer. This quizzer is no longer quizzing so we only have novice/JV quizzers. In December we had to cancel our quiz due to weather. We were disappointed for several reasons – we hate to cancel a quiz, we miss the teens, it’s hard to skip quizzing on the material, and we were looking forward to going to a church new to hosting quizzing. Thank you to Oxford for being willing to host and we hope to have another opportunity to bring quizzing to your church. Because we didn’t want to cancel unless necessary, we held off on making a decision as long as possible. Although we thought we made the decision early enough and in plenty of time, we missed notifying one family by just a few minutes and they drove to the canceled quiz. Our intentions were in the right place, but the experience taught us to call it earlier in the future, if needed.

We just had our January quiz and had six quizzers. This is where the mission and the reason we share in this ministry is important – it’s to get teens into the Word of God and the Word of God into our teens. If even one teens life is changed, the time and effort are worth more than anything. It’s about that... not the number of teens that attend. God had a purpose for each one that was there to be there that day.

The second half of the season will be bitter sweet. It is the last season, at least for now, for both Matt and Pamela. Through God’s strength and grace, we will finish this lap of our race strong!

### **FINANCES**

We charged \$25.00 for registration this year and still charge \$5.00 per student for lunch at every quiz meet and retain a receipt for any expenses to send to Tami, so that each church can be reimbursed. We plan on spending the bulk of our budget (\$1000) and the cash that we have from last year for the Eastern Field Quiz this May. We use this money for T-Shirts and transportation to and from ENC.

## Back to School Rally 2017

This past years B2SR, was held on Friday, September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017. The event was held at Camel Back Resort at their indoor water park area “Aquatopia.” We had in attendance **386 students**, and **103 adults**. Our attendance has gone up from last year with the entrance of the Metro Ney York District joining us in this activity. Metro New York added 46 students to our numbers.

We also had **35 churches** represented in these numbers with combined districts. So overall our attendance went up! The event brought in **\$15,620**. With our overall price for the event at **\$12,000** we came out making **\$3,620**.

Overall the event was a huge success, Camelback as an organization continues to give our group very high praises. Only changes that are to be made will be that chaperones will all be asked to pay a \$20 fee now, instead of being free.

## **NYI Missions annual report - Philly NYI district - April 2018**

- Refresh 2018 - January 14-15, 2018

At this year's Refresh we had 92 students and 18 chaperones that attended. We received \$820 and had expenditures that totaled \$762.66. Refresh 2018 was held at Lansdale ICN. Bobbie Renzi took care of almost all of the logistics of the weekend including preparation of the building, food purchases, bus rental, site calls, breakfast and lunch preparation, clean-up. Students registered by paying \$10 at the door and signed up for the service project. Matt Brown gave the message and Drew Dinnel with a group of teens and young adults lead worship, Noah Golden provided assistance at the soundboard. Games included Gaga, 9-square, and cooperative games such as the food challenge, monster tag, and others. Plans for 10 service projects were cut back to 8 due to lower than planned enrollment and cold weather. All 8 sites were well organized, and students and chaperones expressed joy and fulfillment in serving. Kudos to Bobbie for arranging most of these! Debriefing the day's events at lunch time is always a highlight. Students shared what God had done at each of the service projects. This event, as envisioned by Matt Brown, has become a yearly staple of our youth calendar. In future years, we would like to advertise and communicate dates, times, and logistics of the event earlier and directly to youth leaders. We would like to increase the number of churches represented in 2019.

- Missions trip - July 7, 2018 - July 16, 2018 - Tapachula, Mexico

11 students and 4 chaperones are participating in the Missions trip that attend 6 different Nazarene churches on the Philly district. We will be serving alongside Stephen and Anne Sickel, Nazarene missionaries in Mesoamerica. We have planned a construction projects at District camp in Tapachula and outreach opportunities at the park in Tapachula. The cost of the trip is \$1600 per person(proposed). To date we have collected \$8,853.86. A big thank you to the Philly NMI counsel who will contribute \$2000 towards the construction costs of the project. We have planned 2 training dates -1/27/2018 at Cornerstone Family Church & 4/28/2018 at Hershey Nazarene Church. At your first training, an emphasis of the role of each participant in short term missions was emphasized along with the importance of experiencing other cultures. Our second training will focus on preparation for our outreach into the community when we are there and to experience some authentic Mexican food. Our trip's focus scripture is: *Jesus had loved his disciples during his ministry on earth, and now he showed them the fullest extent of his love.* - John 13:1

We ask for the prayers and support of the Philly NYI as we continue to prepare for this life-changing short term missions trip this summer.
